

# Quilt Top Design & Construction

## Quilt Top

### ***Layout***

**Grid. Describe:** This quilt top has a 5x5 grid with sashing. The 21" of extra length is gained by using horizontal sashing that is wider than the vertical sashing. The pieced blocks are Jacob's ladder. The fabrics are easily sourced over an 80 year time span. The piecing is done by both hand and machine.

# Condition

## Flaws

### Soiling

- Dirty
- Mildew stains

- Stains
- Musty Smell

### Discoloration

- Running / fugitive color

- Faded / bleached color

- Crocking

### Fabric Damage

- Tears / holes
- Thread bare

- Disintegrating / fall out
- Shattering

- Insect damage

### Sewing / Quilting Damage

- Split / open seams
- Quilting threads missing

- Ties / tufting missing
- Batting has shifted

- Embellishments missing

### Storage Issues

- Discoloration from wood

- Damage from acid

- Fold marks / creases
