

Describe: This table runner is a 3x1 block grid with a straight set (no drop). The outside two blocks carry appliqued easter rabbits and the middle blocks is a nine-patch where the corner and center blocks are themselves nine-patches (BB ID 1606a – Fundamental Nine Patch. There are 3 borders and the corners are nine-patches.
