**Additional Information:** The original blocks were purchased on July 31, 2022 as a set of 23 for \$30 or about \$1.30 per block. 20 blocks were used for this top for about \$26.09 for the blocks used. The remaining 3 blocks are still listed as sample 101A.

The vendor provided the original pattern with the blocks. It was an article from Fons & Porter March/April 1999.

I spent another \$7.50 in fabric for the sashing and \$5 for the borders. The top cost about \$39.

At the same time, I made the binding (\$7.50) and backing (52.50). The fabric for the entire quilt cost about \$99.

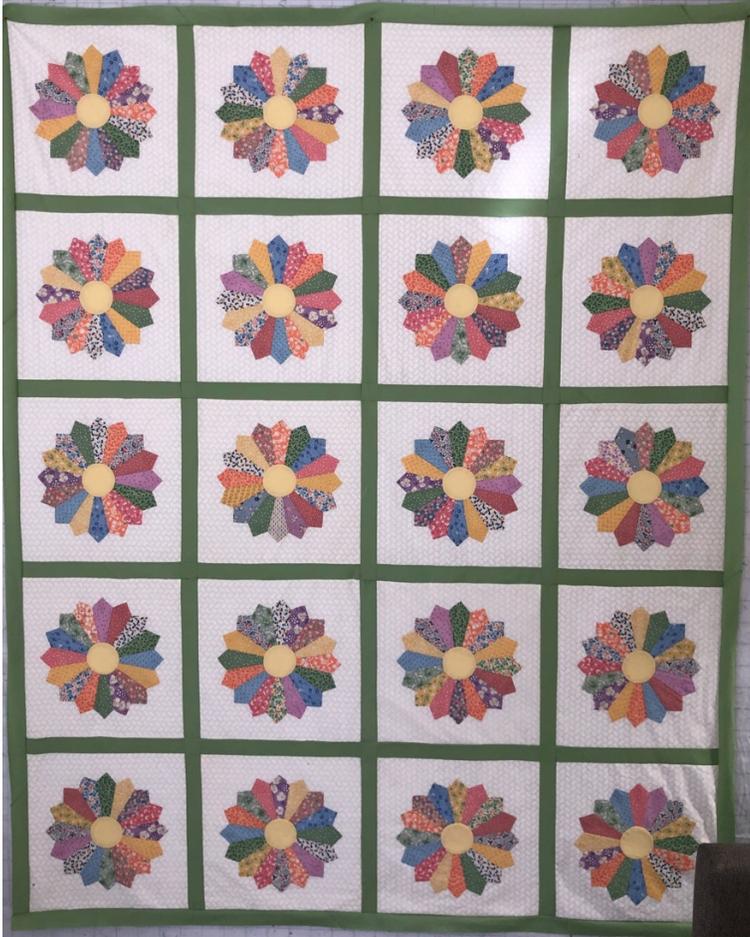
