**Layout Design:** Strips - vertical.

**Describe:** This quilt top is organized into lengthwise strips. the strips are primarily pieced from diamonds and triangles. The fabrics are cotton - solids and prints. The top is assembled by machine. Foundation piecing was used - the remant papers can be found in some of the seam allowances.
