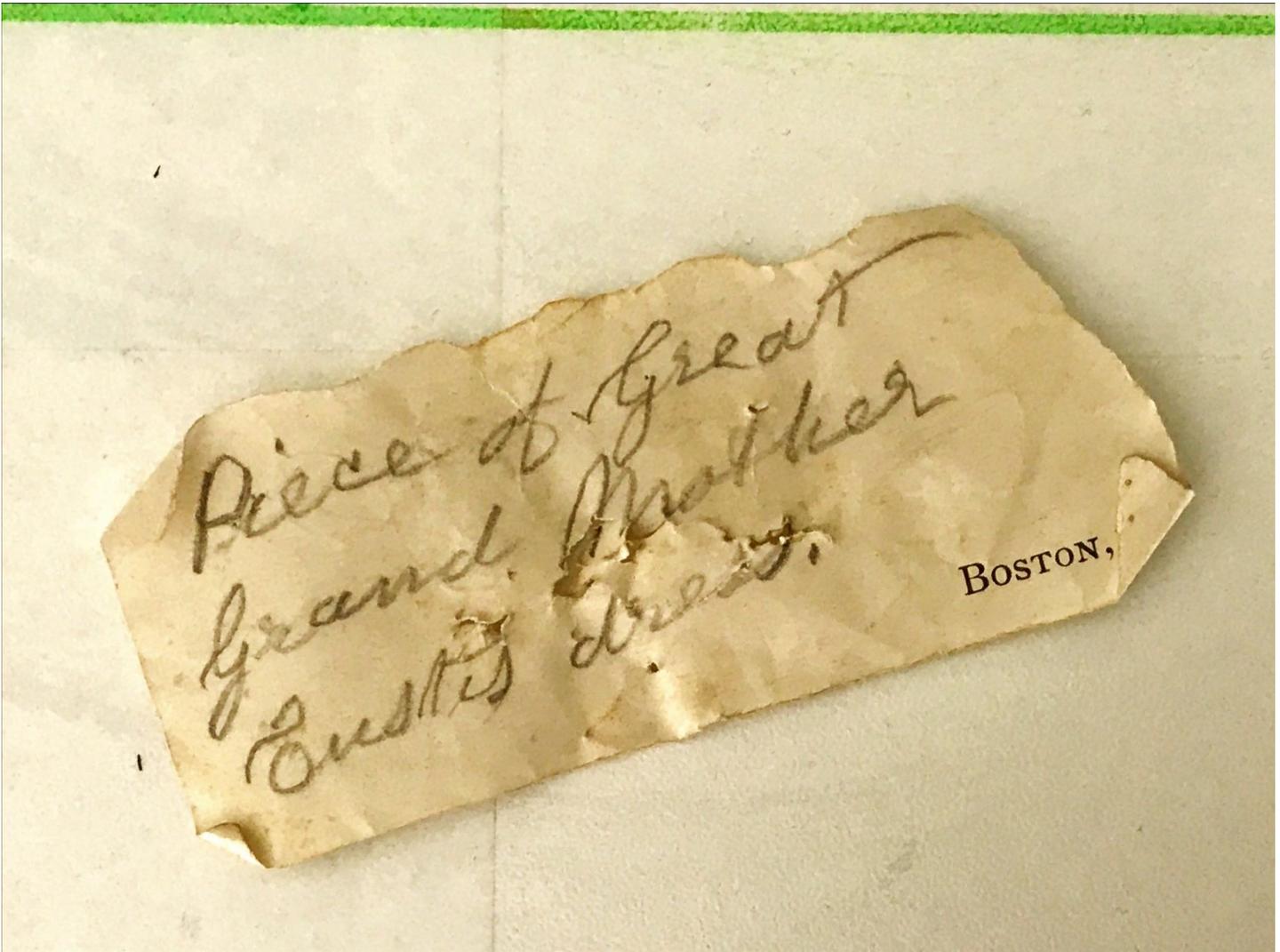

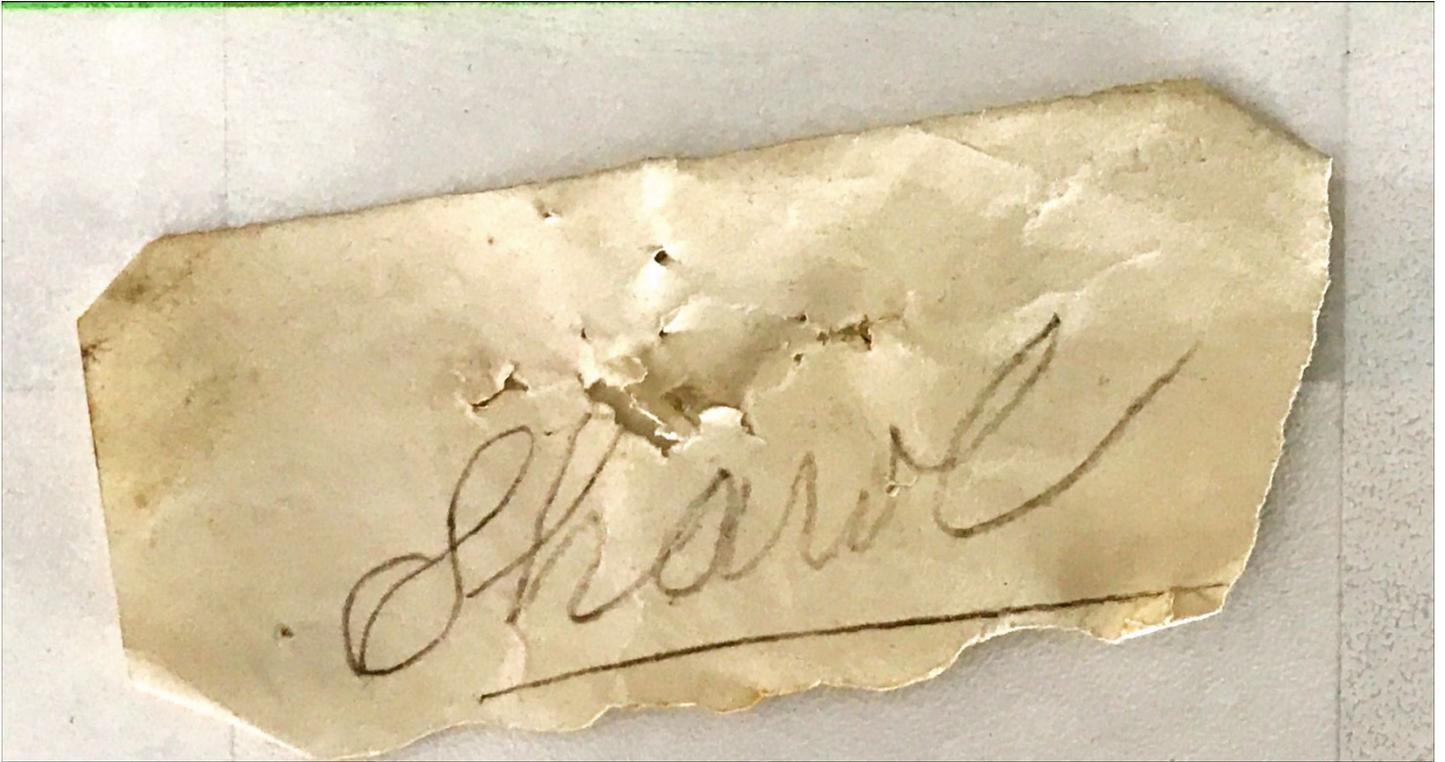

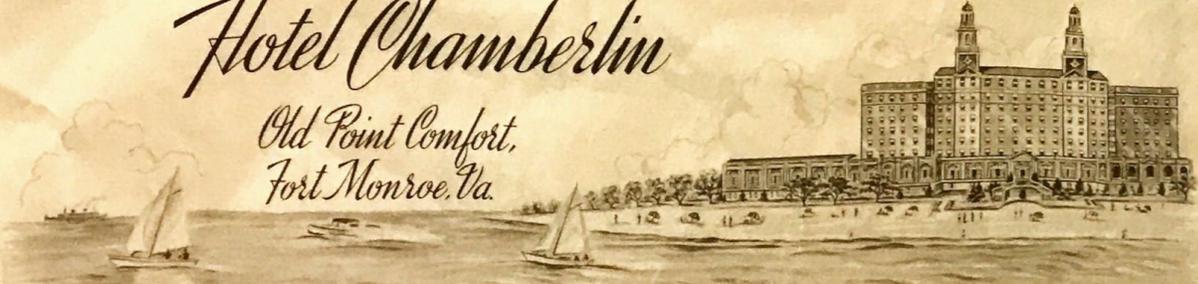

**Additional Information:** This pieced was purchased as part of a set at a live auction at the Fall North West Fabric Study group in Shipshewana, IN. The lot was \$175 and included items 596, 597, 598, 599 and some ephemera. The donor to the auction is unknown. The pieces and ephemera are from Betty Harrigan's fabric collection.

The lining is linen and the outer fabric is silk brocade. Hand stitched.

Two pieces of paper were associated with these items. They are stored in the ephemera collection under their age.

Paper 1: Hotel Stationary. Aside from the hotel's header, the front is blank:
